



Checklist for Korea

It is helpful to check off each item as you do it to keep track of your preparations for coming to Korea.

Documents	Done
1. I have my passport with at least 6 months validity (recommended one year).	
2. I have my original university degree (or notarized copy).	
3. I have three copies of my university transcripts (signed and sealed across the fold).	
4. I have completed my CBC (criminal background check) with appropriate notarization.	
5. I have 4 passport-sized photos, in color, not more than 6 months old.	
6. I have prepared my resume with all my relevant contact information.	
7. I have filled in two copies of the health form.	
8. I have made photocopies of all my important documents.	
9. I have contacted my local Korean embassy to confirm the fees and documents for my visa.	

Friends and Family

Thing to prepare	Done
1. I have all of the contact information for my friends and family back home so that I can keep in touch.	
2. I have signed up for a social networking site like Facebook or MySpace so that I can keep in touch with friends back home and share photos of my time in Korea.	
3. I have spoken with my recruiter and asked all the questions I had.	

Packing for Korea

You might consider bringing the following things with you when you are packing to come to Korea.

Things to pack	Packed
1. some semi-professional formal wear for work	
2. Winter clothing	
3. Deodorant	
4. Supply of vitamin supplements/prescription medicine	
5. Condoms/birth control	
6. Personal items, games, videos and pictures which would help with your classes	

Money and Banking

Thing to prepare	Done
1. I have prepared enough money to last at least until my first payday (recommended at least \$500).	
2. I have all of the information from the bank in my home country to be able to wire money home.
